Concerns about conviction integrity, the collateral consequences of criminal convictions and the ability to re-examine prior convictions through the use of modern forensic techniques such as DNA profiling, have led to an explosion of postconviction litigation in Maryland and across the country. Every criminal law practitioner in the state - prosecutors and defense counsel alike - must be conversant in the different approaches, requirements, and procedures in postconviction litigation, many of which are unique to Maryland. This course will address the vehicles and procedures available for postconviction relief in Maryland and provide a practical guide to postconviction litigation in state and federal courts. Students will learn about motions for new trial, sentence review and modification, the Uniform Postconviction Procedure Act, Petitions for Writ of Actual Innocence, the DNA Postconviction Act, writs of error coram nobis, and state and federal habeas corpus. There will also be discussion of how and why errors occur - ineffective assistance of counsel, newly discovered evidence, discredited witnesses and/or forensic techniques, and the other common elements that arise in postconviction litigation.
