

Mediation Skills – Boswell

This class is taught in an immersion format, with all formal classes held over three weekends. Notwithstanding the compressed scheduling of classes, the course workload is the same as a typical three-credit course at an ABA accredited law school. Students should only register for the course to the extent they are capable and willing to complete the course requirements in the compressed format.

Fall 2018 Teaching Dates:

Weekend One:

Saturday, August 25, 2018, 9:00am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 5:30pm

Sunday, August 26, 2018, 9:00am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 5:30pm

Weekend Two:

Saturday, September 1, 2018, 9:00am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 5:30pm

Sunday, September 2, 2018, 9:00am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 5:30pm

(Please note that these dates coincide with LABOR DAY WEEKEND.)

Weekends Three & Four:

There will be no formal class on the weekends of September 8-9 and September 15-16; however, *each student will be required to attend a two-hour conference with the instructor, to be scheduled on September 7, 8, 9, 14, 15 or 16. (No student observing Rosh Hashana will be scheduled for a conference ending later than 2:00 p.m. on September 9, 2018.) Additionally, any class that is cancelled on Weekends One or Two may be rescheduled on September 8, 9, 15 and/or 16.*

Weekend Five:

Saturday, September 22, 2018, 9:00am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 5:30pm

Sunday, September 23, 2018, 9:00am to 12:30pm and 2:00pm to 5:30pm

Following the final weekend of class, each student will be required to attend an additional two-hour conference with the instructor, to be scheduled on a Friday, Saturday or Sunday – most likely beginning September 28, 2018.

In the event of class cancellations which have not been rescheduled for Weekends Three or Four, the make-up classes would most likely be held on the weekend of September 29-30, 2018.

Additional note: One of the required texts is *When Talk Works: Profiles of Mediators* by Deborah Kolb and Associates. Students who do not wish to purchase this book may arrange to borrow a copy from Professor Boswell for the duration of the class.
