RECIPROCITY POLICY

The University of Baltimore provides services to students and graduates of other law schools within the following guidelines:

- 1. Services are available to all students and graduates of those law schools that allow University of Baltimore law alumni and/or students to use their facilities.
- 2. Requests for services must be made, in writing, by the placement or career counseling administrator prior to the rendering of any services. The student or graduate will receive a letter authorizing their use of our facilities and he/she should bring a copy of his/her letter when visiting our offices. Photo identification will be necessary as well.
- 3. Reciprocity is granted for three months beginning with the initial visit. Reciprocity is **not** available from July 1 through November 15.
- 4. Reciprocity privileges include:
 - a. Use of Career Resource Library Materials
 - b. Use of NALP publications
 - c. Remote access to on-line job bank via Symplicity
- 5. The following services are **not** available:
 - a. On-campus interviewing
 - b. Resume referral
 - c. Participation in job fairs
 - d. Career counseling appointments
- 6. The Law Career Development Office may restrict or revoke reciprocity privileges to any individual who misuses the facilities or services, or to any school surpassing a reasonable number of requests during an academic year.
- 7. Requests for reciprocity can be made to only one of the Maryland law schools.

 Therefore, you may choose either the University of Baltimore <u>or</u> the University of Maryland. There is no reciprocity agreement between the two Maryland law schools.
