**TOPIC: CLIMATE ADAPTATION, LAW & EQUITY**

Course Description: This course explores how domestic, international, and local law meet (and fail to meet) the impacts of climate change. How do climate impacts (from sea level rise to extreme weather events) challenge existing law and environmental governance? What can we learn from new legal and regulatory efforts to plan for climate impacts? And, what do potential changes to law mean for climate justice and environmental justice communities? Students will gain familiarity with the core science and social science behind interconnected legal and ecological systems, and the role of law in addressing climate vulnerability. The class will examine and discuss the interactions among law, climate impacts, and environmental/ecological equity across eight interrelated topics: environmental justice; public health; agriculture; human migration; habitat and non-human migration; sea level rise and coastal management; climate disasters (e.g., wildfires and hurricanes); and water/energy regulation. Readings draw from legal scholarship, social science, and real-world examples of changes and challenges to law as local, regional, and international communities begin to plan for climate change. Students will write a research paper, of publishable quality, that meets the upper level writing requirement. Pre-requisite: Environmental Law or Administrative Law or by permission of the instructor. This course fulfills the upper level scholarly writing requirement.

REPRODUCTIVE RIGHTS & JUSTICE

Course Description: This course will focus on the not only on the right to not have a child but also the rights to have a child, and to raise a child. This focus is through the lens of Reproductive Justice, which is a concept developed by Black Women activists in the 1990s to provide a different framework from Reproductive Rights, to explore how systemic oppression impacts reproductive decision-making. Reproductive Justice activists acknowledge that abortion and contraception were often not the primary reproductive concerns of many marginalized women, including young women, women with disabilities, undocumented women, and queer women. Thus, they adopted a framework that considers the contexts in which reproductive decisions are made. This approach centers social, racial, and economic justice, and focuses as much on the right to have and raise children as it does on the right to safe and legal abortion care and contraceptive access.
